ORIENTATION DAY (EXAMPLE)

(A real life *First-Day-of-School* Plan)

Plan the aspects of this “orientation” day ahead of time. Print a schedule out like this one, and review it together at the beginning of the day explaining this is an “orientation day”. This way, the next day when school work begins in earnest, you will not need to introduce or review these important points below. Your schedule can be any time frame that best fits your family.

8:00 - 9:00	WAKE UP/BREAKFAST/BIBLE VERSES
9:00 - 9:20	INTRODUCE THE “ORIENTATION DAY” SCHEDULE, AND CHORE LIST & DO CHORES (dishes, clean room, walk dog, get school supplies/area ready, etc.)
9:20 - 9:30	Transition Time: Prepare for school work
9:30 - 10:20	<u>1ST SESSION (SESSIONS usually would be school work time. On the “orientation day” , do the following):</u> PICK AND ARRANGE OFFICE CHECK SUPPLIES & BOOKS OR PLACE ORDERS If using “Pace” booklets, don’t forget to pull the “tests” out of the middle of the workbook before giving the workbook to your student! :)
10:20 - 10:30	BREAK
10:30 - 11:20	<u>2ND SESSION:</u> REVIEW SUBJECTS/SCHOOL BOOKS CLOSELY FILL OUT STUDENT “GOAL CHART” (see example) FOR <u>NEXT DAY</u>
11:20 - 12:30	LUNCH AND RECESS
12:30 - 1:20	<u>3RD SESSION:</u> DISCUSS AND DESCRIBE <u>PORTFOLIO</u> , MAKE FILES FOR <u>CATAGORIES</u> DISCUSS THE <u>MONTHLY REPORT YOU WILL BE SUBMITTING TO SCHOOL</u> DISCUSS <u>BOOK REPORT OUTLINE & GRADING SCALE & ASSIGNMENT QUALITY</u>
1:20-1:30	BREAK
1:30-2:20	<u>4TH SESSION:</u> DISCUSS <u>BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS</u> DISCUSS ANY <u>BEHAVIORAL CHART</u> PARENT WILL USE DISCUSS PRIVILEGES/DEMERITS/ HOMEWORK/SCHEDULE CHANGES
2:20-3:00	CLEAN UP & COMPLETE UNFINISHED WORK
3:00	STUDENT IS TO PUT GOAL CHART AND WORK AWAY. PARENT/TEACHER DOES CHECKS GOAL CHART AND MAINTAINS THE MONTHLY REPORT THAT WILL BE SENT TO THE SCHOOL (Homework for unfinished work can be scheduled for the evening.)
